Committee Mission

This committee works with the Office of Student Integrity to help review policies dealing with matters of academic misconduct.

Executive Board Oversight Committee

This year there were discussions concerning the mission of this committee and the reasons for its existence. The Executive Board Oversight Committee met to discuss the matter, and the AIC also discussed this issue in committee meetings. There were ideas put forth that this committee should merge with the Student Honor Committee. However, it is unclear if the Student Honor Committee wants to increase its role in policy issues in addition to their role of hearing student appeals.

Office of Student Integrity (OSI) Educational Outreach Review

Our committee reviewed a new video to educate students on the process that starts if they are involved in an academic misconduct allegation. The committee thought the video was informative and was very professional. OSI has also been educating different organizations on campus about the new sanction model, which includes the athletic department.

Review of Impact of New Sanction Model

The committee heard a report from the Office of Student Integrity concerning the current impact of the new sanction model. So far the new model seems to be working well. Surprisingly, so far, there have not been that many “two-time” offenders as of March 2015. It is unclear why this is the case.
