SUBJECT: Report of the Activities of the Faculty Status & Grievance Committee for the 2005-2006 Year

The Faculty Status & Grievance Committee (FSGC) began the year with one open case from the previous year. This case was resolved through an informal hearing. During the fall semester one additional case was filed and accepted for investigation but was withdrawn by the complainant from consideration by the FSGC. Late in the spring semester four additional cases were filed and accepted for investigation by the FSGC/. . These open cases were complicated by summer schedules of the committee and other parties and have been carried forward into the 2006-2007 year. Thus, total of six cases were considered during the year.

At the September 2006 meeting of the FSGC, the Committee welcomed its new member Dr. Marion Usselman (CEISMC) and reviewed six new cases filed over the summer and the initial weeks of the fall term. Four were accepted for investigation and the committee granted one additional request for an informal hearing. The remaining case was carried over to a later FSGC meeting for consideration. Tony Wasilewski (GTRI) was elected as Chair for 2006-2007, and Professor Jack Feldman (PSYCH) was re-elected as Secretary.
