1. The next meeting was set for Wednesday, February 11 at 12:00 Noon.
2. The Registrar asked the Committee if it had any input on some additional language for the Registrar's Office website to help explain enrollment status. There have been questions as to whether enrollment in online classes constitutes "being enrolled" at Tech. This does not constitute a change in policy, but rather the addition of some clarifying language on the website.

“Note: A student is considered enrolled when he/she is registered for GT classes, for any grade mode and any delivery method. Regardless of how the class is delivered or which grade mode is selected, registered hours are what determine enrollment status. Registration in online academic courses, for example, operates the same way as courses taken on campus.”

3. The Registrar asked the Committee to review the Grade Substitution policy to determine if it needs to be amended to explain what the term “in residence” means. This seems to have created confusion among students and academic advisors. After some discussion, it was determined that this is likely a question of training and education, not an issue of how the policy is written. It was suggested that the Registrar work with the academic advisors on campus to review the policy and make sure that everyone understands it.
